- 2:30pm Stadium Road opens for all trailer traffic.
- 3:00pm Pit Gates Open  
(You must have your tickets with you at this time. If you need to purchase a ticket, this can be done at the Ticket Booth at the Main Gate from 3:30pm).
- 4:00pm Public Main Gates Open

- Drivers' briefing will be held in the club rooms at 4:30 pm.  
This is for drivers only.
- Wheel Pack starts at 5:10pm for all classes.
- Racing Starts 6.00pm

#### Series sponsor logo

The competitor may be required to apply the Series sponsor logo on their car. The location of this logo will be in a place where it can be seen by the patrons watching the racing from the terraces.

#### SNZ Rules

- The event will be run according to the 2017 Speedway New Zealand rule book with the exception of the local rules and race format.
- As per SNZ Rules, no vehicles shall exceed 95 dBA. The Steward may exclude any vehicle that exceeds the noise limits.

#### Lap Scoring:

- The meetings at Bay park & Palmerston North will have AMB Electronic Lap scoring.
- Raceceiver rental transmitters are available to visiting drivers at Western Springs on the night.



## Format

The promoter(s) reserves the right to change the format.

The Local Rules used at Springs Speedway will apply to all formats at all three venues.

This includes the double file restart throughout the entire race. It also includes the restart rule relating to setting the pace and restarting the race.

## Qualifying:

1. All competitors will compete in the heats, which will be seeded to ensure there are no 'stacked' heats.
2. All competitors will be divided into 5 groups, so each group races a different group each night. The heat races will be 10 lap races.
3. Cars will qualify for the Feature through these two heats, in combining the points gained from each heat. The points will be 1st – 20 Points, 2nd – 19 Points, 3rd – 18 Points and so on. Points will only be allocated to those who finish the race.
4. The top 16 qualifiers will transfer to the Feature.
5. The non-qualified competitors will start the Semi Main.
6. The remaining 4 positions will be filled by the top 4 place getters in the B Main. The Semi Main will start fastest from the front, with the first non-qualifier starting on the front row. He/She may select the inside or outside position on the front row.

## Teams Racing:

This requires the 6 selected representatives to compete in a 'teams race' for their country.

### The Team Race will run on all four nights of the Series.

- The drivers will fly their respective tail flags from the rear of their wing.
- The nominated 'Captains' of each team will draw a marble with the Commentary Team on the infield, to determine which set of grids his country will start in.
- Marble 1            Team starts on Row 1  
Marble 2            Team starts on Row 2  
Marble 3            Team starts on Row 3.

At the completion of the 4-lap sprint, the teams will roll back one row and so on for each of the next two sprint races.

The Team with the most combined points will stop on the in-field podium to be awarded their prize cheques.

### **Pole Shuffle – Round 4 (Sat 8<sup>th</sup> December 2018)**

1. The six (6) drivers with the highest points accumulated in the heats, will participate in the Pole Shuffle to determine the Feature starting grid order.
2. If competitors are tied on points, the fastest lap time from the heats of that night will determine which driver transfers to the Pole Shuffle.
3. These competitors will race 2 at a time over 2 laps, starting with the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> qualifier and so on. The winner of each shuffle race will remain on track and race the next qualifier.
4. The new competitor entering the shuffle race will choose which grid they want.
5. The car starting on the outside will set the pace.
6. The winner of the pole shuffle may choose which front grid position they prefer for the Feature Race.

### **New Zealand Team Selection:**

As per the SNZ Rule M4-34, there is a process to follow in the selection of the NZ Team members. The two-person team will be selected as follows:

- The two (2) team members will be chosen by the SNZ three-person panel.
- The selection will be held in confidence by this group and announced on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> November once racing is finished.

In order to qualify, you must compete in the class at one of the two Series rounds, on or before the 10<sup>th</sup> November 2018 at Western Springs.
